



More ways to pay on public transport

Tap-on with Opal, or use a contactless payment card or linked device

It's never been easier to jump on public transport for your journey with more ways to pay for your fare.

Opal benefits

Use an Opal card, contactless card or linked device to access Opal benefits. Benefits of using an Opal card or the same contactless card or linked device include:

- \$2 discount for every transfer between modes (train, ferry, bus or light rail) as part of one journey. The Opal transfer discount does not apply when transferring between light rail and Sydney Ferries.
- Weekly travel reward – half price travel after eight paid journeys in a week
- Daily adult fare capped at \$16.10
- Weekly adult fare capped at \$50
- 30% discount with weekday off-peak metro/train fares (before 7am, between 9am and 4pm and after 6.30pm).

Contactless payments

Contactless is a quick and easy way to pay for your trip on public transport on the Opal network.

- If you have an American Express, Mastercard or Visa credit or debit card or a linked device, you can use it to pay for your travel by tapping on and tapping off at Opal readers. Just look for the contactless payment symbol. Contactless payments are available on all public transport in the Opal network (not accepted for Transport Park&Ride or On Demand services).
- You will receive the same travel benefits of an adult Opal card and pay an adult fare when you tap on and tap off consistently with the same credit card, debit card or linked device.
- If you're unsure whether your card is contactless enabled, check with your card issuer.
- Always separate your cards when you tap on and tap off so your preferred card is charged.
- Always use the same card or linked device to access Opal benefits.
