



Circular Quay investigation update 2 May 2018.

The NSW Government has announced it is committed to upgrading the Circular Quay ferry wharves. The wharves need to be upgraded to make them accessible for all customers and support future growth.

As part of this work, Transport for NSW (TfNSW) is conducting investigations at Circular Quay and the immediate surrounding area through to July 2018. No work will take place during the VIVID festival between 25 May to 16 June due to the high number of people in the Circular Quay precinct during this time.

TfNSW is committed to minimising the impact. Sydney Trains, ferries, water taxis, jet boats and other private boat services will all continue to operate. Access to ferry wharves, properties and businesses will be maintained.

The geophysical surveying, some of which has been completed, will continue for a further week. The noise generating activities associated with this survey work is now complete. Marine geophysical work will continue.

Construction hours

Day: 7am to 5pm

Night: 7pm to 5am

Upcoming geotechnical investigations from **7 to 24 May** involves drilling of:

- ▶ Four land-based boreholes on the southern, eastern and western sections of the promenade of Circular Quay. These will be enclosed within fenced and screened sites of either 6.5 x 4 metres or 10 x 5 metres, depending on the space available. The boreholes are approximately 150mm in diameter and the worksites for drilling will be occupied for approximately 24 to 48 hours.
- ▶ Eight water-based boreholes up to 40 metres below the seabed. The boreholes will be drilled at each location over a 24 to 48 hour period from a temporary jack-up barge in the Harbour and in Circular Quay.

Noise

Noise will be generated during borehole drilling operations, including some sporadic, intermittent noise generated by specialised testing. All machinery will be switched off when not in use and/or reduced to idle speed to minimise noise.

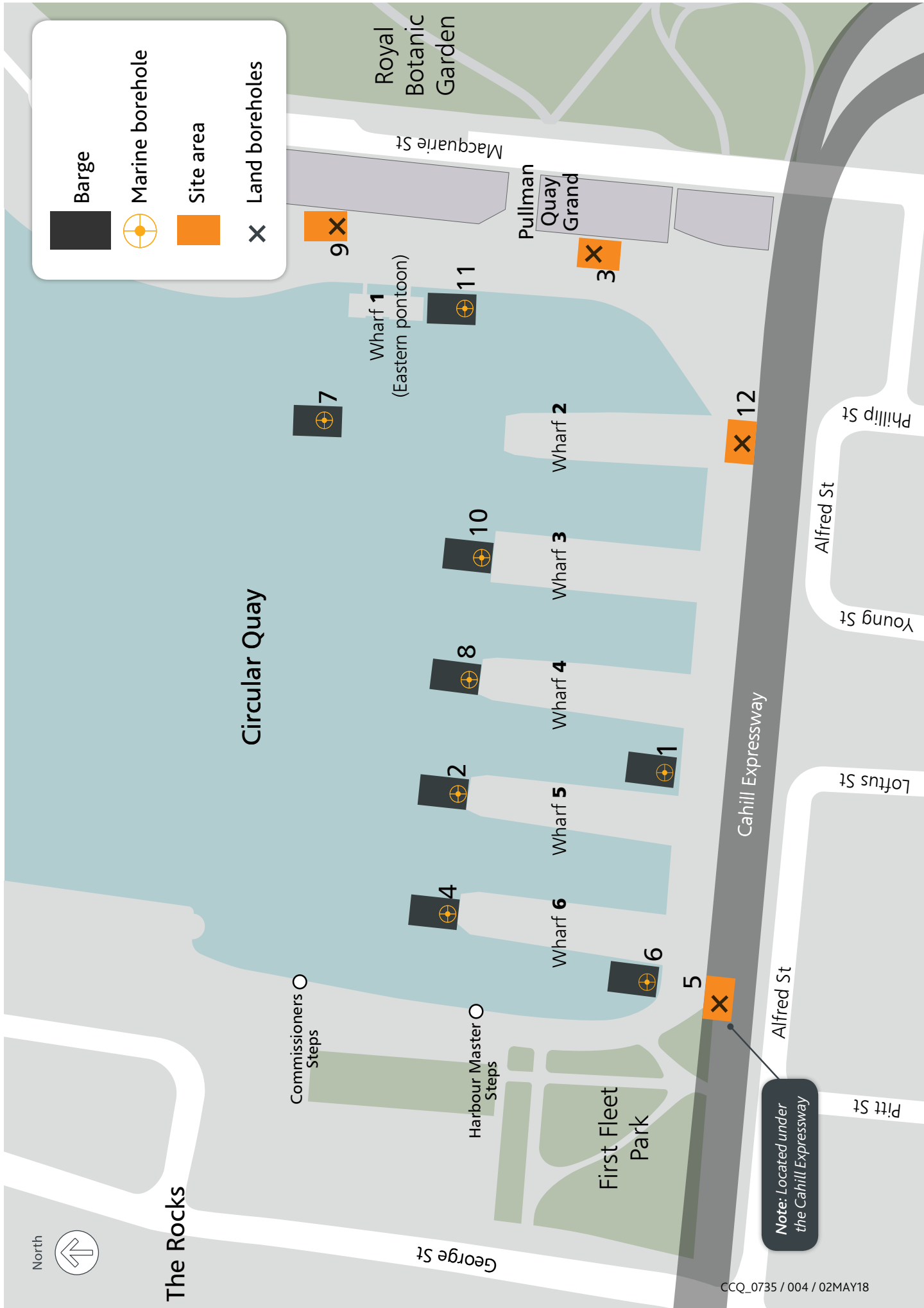
