



## Wynyard Station construction will be taking place from 1 December 2016

In planning for Tomorrow's Sydney we are upgrading Wynyard Station to provide increased customer capacity and create a new gateway to Barangaroo and Sydney's financial district.

### What we're doing at Wynyard

During December work will continue to improve customer amenity at the station and to prepare for the York Street lobby refurbishment and escalator upgrade.

### Thursday 1 to Saturday 31 December

**Day works:**

7am to 6pm Monday to Sunday

**Night works:**

7pm to 6am Monday to Sunday

Work taking place during this period includes:

- Installing fixtures and finishes on platforms, including cable trays.
- Platform control room painting and fit out work, including installing doors.
- Completion of concourse and platform architectural finishes including ceilings and tiling.
- Heat relief system trial on Platforms 3 and 4.

### Sydney Trains trackwork weekends

In addition to the work described above, Sydney Trains will be undertaking track maintenance work on the following two weekends in December:

**Saturday 3 December to Sunday 4 December**

During this time Platform 6 will be closed while we will install new fixtures and finishes. Platform 5 will remain open to the public.

**Saturday 10 December to Sunday 11 December**

During this time Platforms 3 and 4 will be closed while we install the prototype heat relief system.

### How will these works affect you?

#### Heat relief system trial on Platforms 3 and 4

Novo Rail is working with Transport for NSW to investigate and trial options for heat relief on platforms to improve customer comfort.

During December, a heat relief system prototype will be temporarily installed on a small section of platforms 3 and 4. It will aim to test the prototype's effectiveness in providing heat relief to customers.

Transport for NSW will seek customer feedback as part of the trial, which will be considered in terms of feasibility, cost and benefit.

The trial will run until late January 2017.

#### Traffic and pedestrian changes

Major changes will take place over weekends and work will continue behind the hoarding and temporary fencing 24 hours per day, seven days a week.

Parts of the concourse and platforms will be temporarily closed while work is completed; however, access to both will be maintained at all times.

Deliveries to and from site may occur via Cumberland Street, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Subject to approval, deliveries may also be made via George Street and York Street between 10pm and 5am, Monday to Sunday.

## Noise and dust

You may experience some noise during this work. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to residents and businesses while work takes place

Where required, any dust generating activities will be watered down and vehicles will be switched off when not in use to minimise noise.

When working at height, workers will use ladders, scaffolds and elevated work platforms to reach the ceiling. Plastic sheeting will be used to shield customers from any dust that is made while working in the ceiling, where required.
