



Wynyard Station construction will be taking place from January 2017

In planning for Tomorrow's Sydney we are upgrading Wynyard Station to provide increased customer capacity and an improved gateway to Barangaroo and Sydney's financial district.

What we're doing at Wynyard

From January 2017 access to the station via York Street will be temporarily closed so that the York Street lobby can be refurbished and the escalators replaced.

A new lift and upgraded escalators will make it easier and safer for customers to access Wynyard Station from York Street. The upgrade will also improve the reliability of the escalators and reduce required maintenance.

A Heritage Interpretation strategy is being developed to document the heritage significance of the York Street lobby including the escalators. Heritage elements will be incorporated into the new design and finishes, where appropriate.

The York Street entrance is expected to re-open in late 2017.

What you will see

From 2 January the York Street entrance will be closed and temporary fencing and construction hoarding will be installed at York Street and on the station concourse.

During construction new fixtures and finishes will be installed in the lobby, including a new passenger lift and upgraded escalators.

All work will take place behind construction hoarding or temporary fencing.

Work hours

Day works: 7am to 6pm Monday to Sunday

Night works: 7pm to 6am Monday to Sunday

How will these works affect you?

Pedestrian changes

The York Street entrance will be closed during the refurbishment. Access to the footpath on York Street will be maintained. Signage will be in place to direct customers and extra staff will be on hand to help direct customers at key times.

Traffic changes

Deliveries to and from site may occur via Cumberland Street, 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Subject to approval, deliveries may also be made via George Street, York Street and York Lane between 10pm and 5am, Monday to Sunday.

Large and oversize deliveries will be made at night via York Street and will require a partial road closure of the westbound lanes on York Street. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place to ensure the safety of pedestrians and road users. Affected stakeholders will be notified where required.

Noise and dust

You may experience some noise during this work. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to residents and businesses while work takes place.

Where required, any dust generating activities will be watered down and vehicles will be switched off when not in use to minimise noise.
