Out of hours work

From Sunday 6 May – Saturday 19 May 2018

Some work activities will be undertaken from **Sunday 6 May to Saturday 19 May 2018 over a number of weeks from Sundays to Thursdays from 8pm - 6am each night**. This involves work on the gangway pivots. Work will be carried out behind a concrete wall and under the gangway.

Equipment to be used includes a jackhammer, welder, generator, angle grinders and other hand and power tools. The hand and power tool work will involve short durations of hammering and grinding. Jack hammering will be limited to 8pm to midnight from Sunday 6 May to Tuesday 8 May. A noise blanket will be used to reduce the impact of noise. Every effort will be made to keep noise levels to a minimum while this important work is being undertaken.
